## About Whiskey & Boots

Whiskey & Boots is a Perth-based performance company. They make Headphone Verbatim Performance work that examines the challenges and contradictions of the human condition. Using storytelling with music, they take real stories gathered from a community and share them publicly, illuminating moments that are familiar, expose common challenges and secret fears, reminding audiences that we are all complex, beautiful, brave, funny, flawed, and vulnerable. Their work is low-fi, stripped back and welcoming, the fourth wall doesn't exist. Through the sharing of honest moments in intimate spaces, they aim to help people understand each other better, boldly, honestly, playfully.

## About The Quadrangle

The Quadrangle is a unique verbatim theatre performance that explores the candid perspectives of young people. In this production, actors present live interviews with children, and relay the words exactly as they hear them, without any embellishment. Accompanied by live music, this performance captures the raw, heartfelt, and humorous insights of children as they share their views on life, the world, and their dreams for the future. The show inspires reflection on the value of young voices and their often-profound wisdom.

# Artist Biographies

## GEORGIA KING

Georgia King, a versatile artist and educator, is a pivotal member of Whiskey & Boots, contributing significantly to their acclaimed productions like *The Bystander Project*, *Mama Stitch*, *The Loneliest Number*, and *THE ONE* by Jeffrey Jay Fowler at Fringe World 2017. In 2015, Georgia produced *Benjamin & Me* for Whiskey & Boots, premiering at The Blue Room before touring with the Queensland Music Festival and regional Western Australia. She co-founded Little y Theatre Company in 2010, playing pivotal roles in productions such as *Scent Tales* (Blue Room's Best Production 2011), its 2013 CircuitWest regional tour, *Slut*, *Glengarry Glen Ross* (Audience Development Award, Blue Room 2012), *Public Space* (FW Best WA Performance 2013), *Second Hands* (nominated for Best New Play, PAWA Awards 2015, runner-up, Martin Sims Awards 2014), and *Rabbit Head*. Georgia also produced for Ribs' *Interrupting A Crisis* and The Lost Boys' *Moving On Inc.*, *Latitudes*. She contributed as Assistant Producer to the 2014 and 2015 Proximity Festival. Her acting roles include *The Little Mermaid*, *Fat Pig*, and *Giving Up the Ghosts*. Georgia, a respected Equity member since 2011, has received four Equity Guild/PAWA Award nominations and two Best Individual Performance nominations at The Blue Room Theatre Awards. More recently, Georgia was honoured with the prestigious Performing Arts WA Award 2023 for Outstanding Performer in a Leading Role.



## MARK STOREN

Mark Storen, a dynamic artist from Perth, excels as a performer, musician, writer, director, and educator. As a founding member of Whiskey & Boots, he actively participates in diverse creative endeavours. His recent work includes notable productions like *The Bystander Project* and *Mama Stitch*.

Mark has also contributed to *The Loneliest Number* and *THE ONE* by Jeffrey Jay Fowler, earning three Fringe World Awards. *Benjamin & Me* received a Best Performance nomination at the Blue Room Awards. Mark's directorial portfolio encompasses projects such as *Ruben Guthrie* and *Teeth 2 Tail* for Curtin University, *The Man and The Moon* for Variegated Productions, *The Dirty Cowboy* (Assistant Director) for Steamworks and Tim Solly, and *Glengarry Glen Ross* for Little y Theatre Company. His work has garnered acclaim both nationally and internationally, with productions like *The Polite Gentleman* (nominated for five Blue Room Awards, Best Production Team winner), *A Drunken Cabaret*, and *Cut to The Quick*. Mark maintains strong collaborative relationships with esteemed organisations, including Barking Gecko Arts, Spare Parts Puppet Theatre, The Last Great Hunt, and Black Swan State Theatre Company. Recently, Mark completed a Graduate Diploma in Education Secondary (Drama) and remains dedicated to inspiring and educating through his creative pursuits.



## BRIDGET TURNER

Singer, songwriter and photographer Bridget Turner is a stalwart of the WA music community. Best known for her work in folk harmony darlings Simone & Girlfunkle and Boys Boys Boys, she is never happier than when she is lost in songwriting or capturing moments behind the camera. This love has taken her around Australia and the world, performing and capturing moments and faces. Her works include ABC's *Giggle & Hoot*, SBS' *Top Knot Detective*, and London Science Museum's, *The Quest for Wonder* featuring Professor Brian Cox. Works also have found placement onto popular television programs/films including *H is for Happiness*, *Winners and Losers*, *Packed to the Rafters*, *Drop Dead Diva*, *Awkward* and on *90210*.



## CLAUDIA TERO

Claudia has established themselves as one of WA's most exciting up-and-coming creatives. An artist in the way of sound, paint and anything that churns out a feeling. Claudia is best known for their musical project, Claudie Joy and The Joy Boys, and their subsequent success across the Perth music scene. The project has seen support slots for Spacey Jane, Jack Davies & the Bush Chooks and a myriad of others. Claudia has previously worked with Whiskey & Boots on their ongoing project, *Mama Stitch*.
